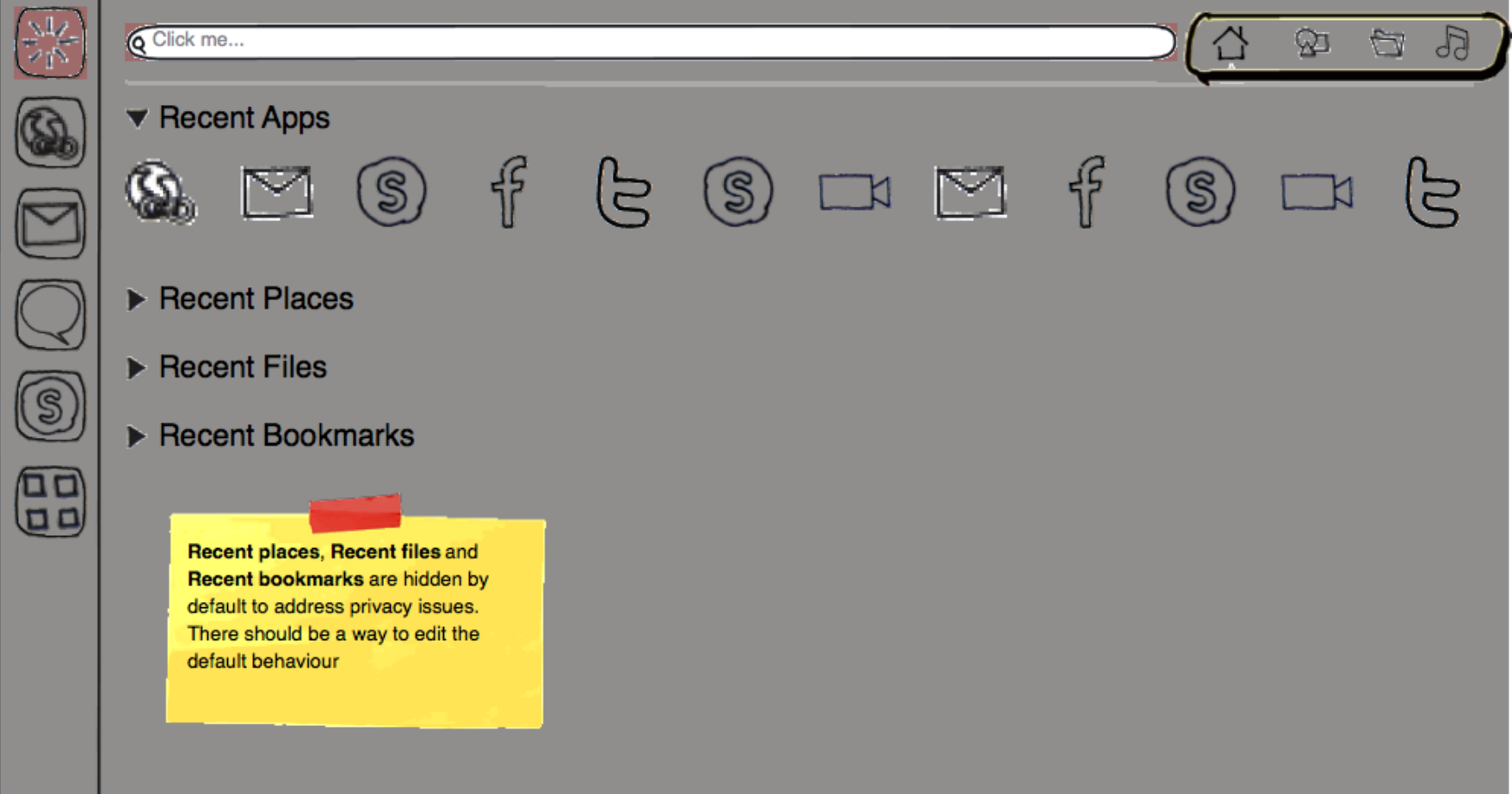




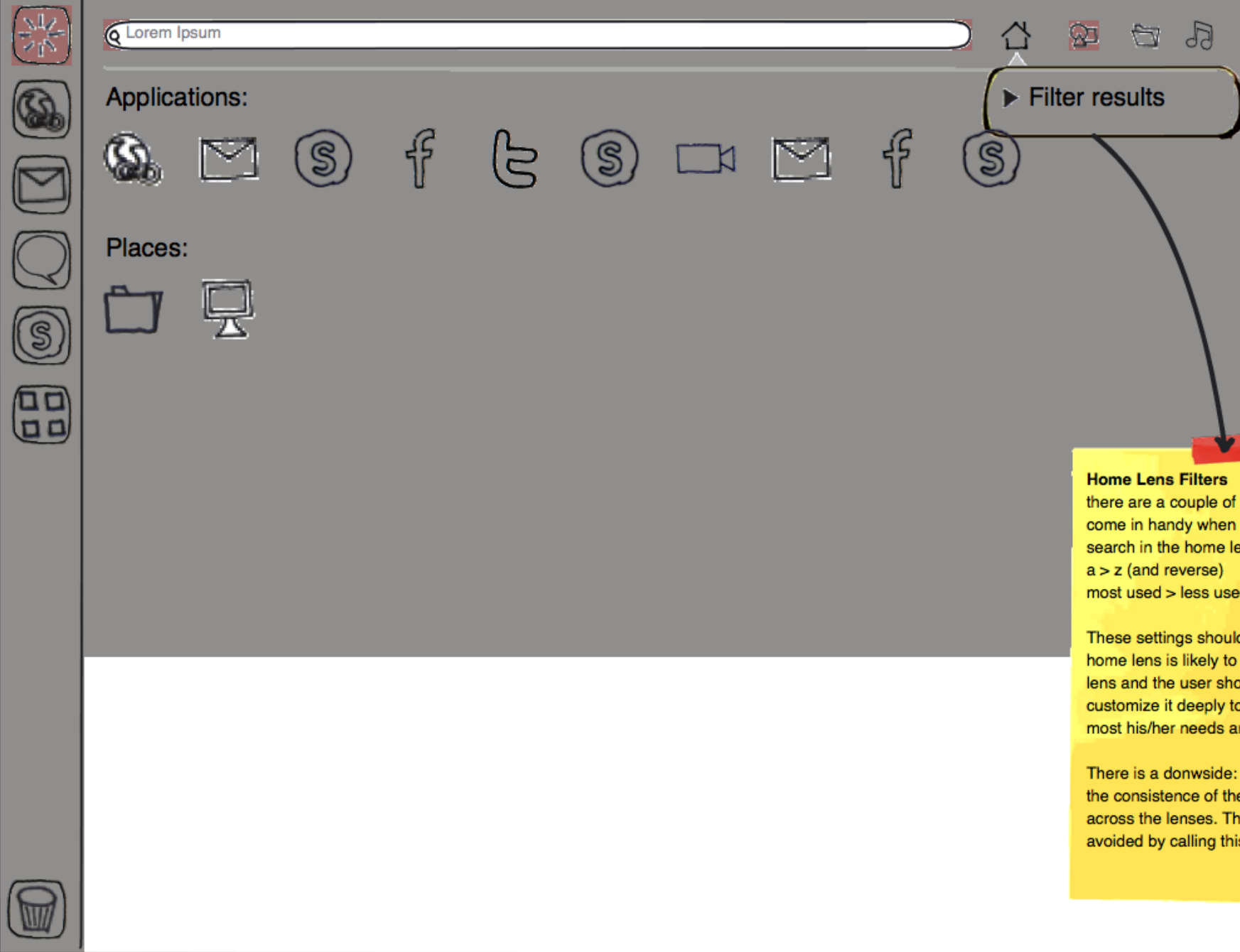
**Lenses: a Fitt's law approach**

**Lenses** are placed next to the search field to improve the usability of the dash according to Fitt's law.

**Recent places, Recent files and Recent bookmarks** are hidden by default to address privacy issues. There should be a way to edit the default behaviour



► Filter results

**Filtering options** are placed under the icons, to keep all the "refining" tools in one place

**Home Lens Filters**  
 there are a couple of filters that could come in handy when performing a search in the home lens:  
 a > z (and reverse)  
 most used > less used (and reverse)

These settings should be persistent: the home lens is likely to be the most used lens and the user should be allowed to customize it deeply to make it suit the most his/her needs and use patterns.

There is a downside: this could break the consistence of the user experience across the lenses. This could be avoided by calling this option "Settings"
