Albay lies at the southern tip of Luzon and at the center of the Bicol region. During the exploration of Juan de Salcedo in 1573, the province and its neighboring areas were known as 'Ibalon'. A small settlement by a mangrove swamp was a town called Albaybay (meaning "by the bay"). The town was first renamed Albay, then Legaspi, as Albay went on to refer to the province.
