This is what should happen **on hover**.
The user can easily discover the available interactions by simply moving the mouse pointer over the application list.
Current USC design makes it difficult for a new user to understand what to do. A mouse click is not the best option, if the aim is good discoverability of complex functions.

It would be better, in my opinion, to move the install button next to the more info button. this would avoid cross-screen trips to perform a single click.

(this is an issue i came across since the first time i used the USC on my 23" fullHD screen: it is a **long** way from the left to the right edge of that screen:)
